

Transfer Credit Guide

The list identifies the general education courses required at Limestone University and suggested courses that can be taken at a technical college in South Carolina to fulfill the Gen Ed requirements. This is a guide for transfer students, and students are not required to take all courses listed for the technical college prior to transferring. The courses listed for the technical colleges is a general listing. Please reference the transfer agreement for additional information. * You should be aware that courses must be passed with *a grade of C or higher* in order to be considered for transfer credit. Students will take **ID120**, **150 or 201** with Limestone, as part of the general education requirements. Students transferring 30 credits or more will take ID 201.
